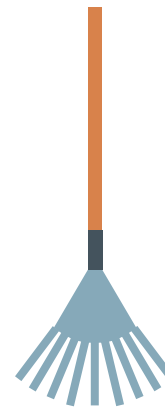

Friday, May 5, 2023

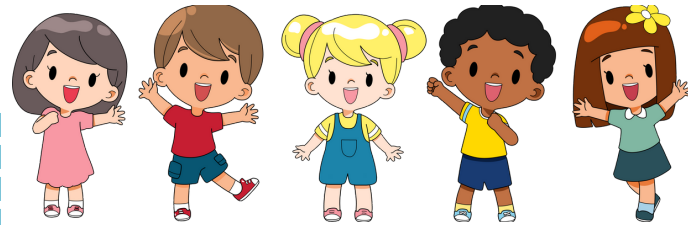
Excitement is heating up around the Spring Fling Silent Auction to support learning enhancements for St. Joseph's! Among the items available to bid on are:

This program intends to build a stronger foundation in French learning skills for students grouped by grade levels.

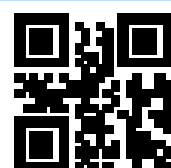
French Conversation Advanced
