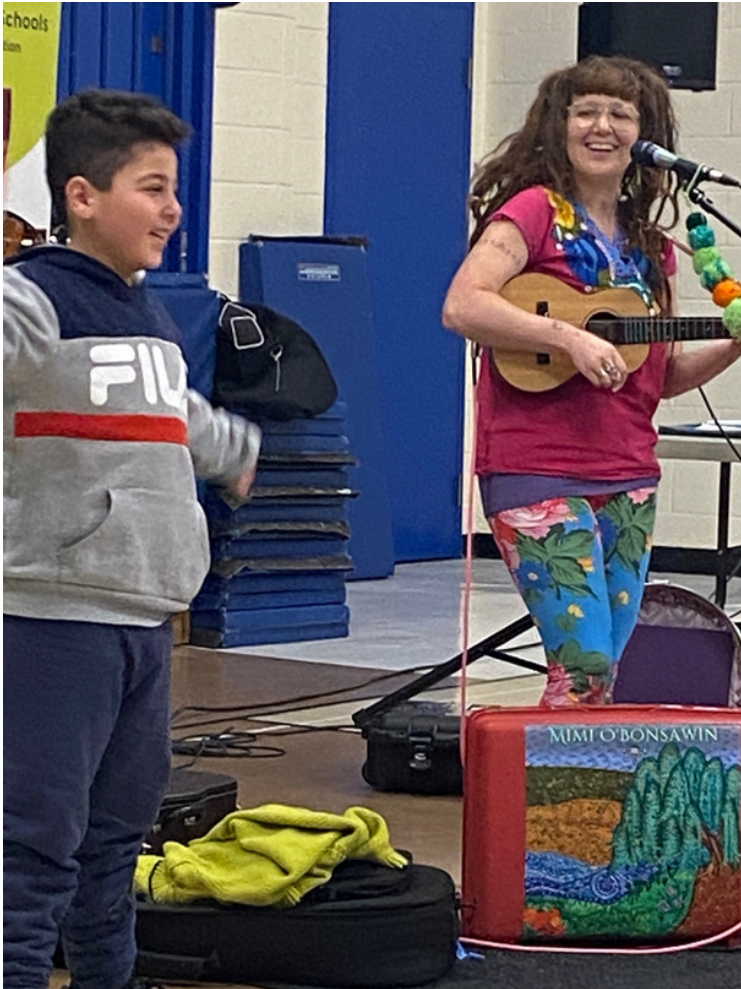

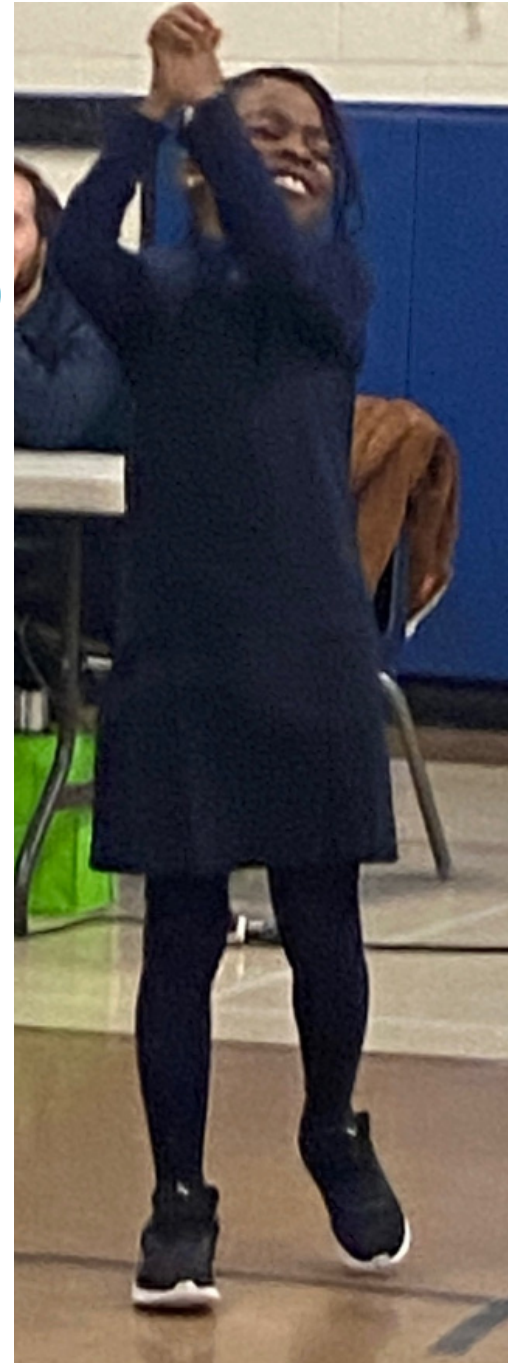


Week at a Glance: March 18-22, 2024
